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School council chairs were invited to attend four District Council / Parent Involvement Committee (DSC-PIC) meetings in the 2020-2021 school year.

Meetings were held virtually to align with COVID-19 Protocols.

### Meeting Synopsis

#### December 3, 2020

Director Hahn shared information with DSC-PIC regarding the 'First 100 Days' Report outlining his first 100 days in the Director of Education role with Trillium Lakelands District School Board. Director Hahn also outlined TLDSB Return to School Plan that was implemented in September, current COVID-19 protocols, and the Learn@Home model some students opted to enrol in for the 2020-2021 school year.

#### January 21, 2021

Director Hahn shared information with DSC-PIC regarding provincial COVID-19 restrictions and the requirement for all students to engage in remote learning following the holiday break. New-to-board Superintendent Jay MacJanet also attended the DSC-PIC Meeting to share an overview of K-8 Curriculum Portfolio, and Superintendent Jennifer Johnston provided a Special Education Programs Update and an Equity Plan Update.

#### March 11, 2021

Director Hahn provided an update to DSC-PIC including sharing information regarding the TLDSB Feed All Four Fund. Superintendent Johnston attended DSC-PIC to share the results of the IEP Survey that TLDSB's Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) recently conducted.

During the second half of the meeting, with funds from the Parents Reaching Out Grant (PRO) DSC-PIC welcomed author Ann Douglu for a presentation on 'Parenting in the Pandemic.'

#### May 6, 2021

Director Hahn provided an update on both Ministry of Education and Board activities including a COVID-19 update, the budget for 2021-2022, and planning for 2021-2022.

Following the Director's update, the DSC-PIC meeting was opened to parents across the board join to hear Guest Speaker Dr. Michael Ungar speak on the topic of 'Nurturing children's resilience during the pandemic.' The speaker was supported via PRO grant funds.
