- Will support all aspects of the program, which is led by qualified teachers

- Will support children with their learning and help to provide a safe, caring, and fun Summer Learning Program.

Responsibilities

- Be a role model through active and inclusive participation in all aspects of the program.
- Support daily programming, such as playing, reading games, supervising children, organizing learning materials, leading activities, and assist with daily record keeping as needed.
- Take direction from Summer Learning teachers.
- Participate in mandatory TLDSB training.

- Responsible with strong communication skills
