



What is the boundary review?

TLDSB establishes school catchment areas within specific boundaries to help balance school enrolment and capacity, minimize transportation, and maximize walk zones.

In this review, we are looking at the school facilities, programs offered, and any limitations at all three schools. Overall, we want to provide the best possible programming for our students.

Areas in consideration during the review

Programming: With any change, our staff will reflect the needs of the students.

Child care: We expect there will be no change to before and/or after care.

School facilities: All three schools have modern buildings, vibrant libraries, large gymnasiums, and are accessible.

Outdoor space: All three schools have large outdoor spaces for learning and playing.

Legacy/grandfathering: We're looking at options for this year's Grade 6 students to stay at their current school to finish their educational journey with their peers. We're also looking at an option for JK students to enrol in their future home school for this September 2023.

Transportation: We are looking at all transportation factors under the proposed options.

Timing: We are conducting this review now to give families advance notice and to ensure we are being thoughtful in our approach.

What's next?

The Board is at the beginning stages of this review, which includes the consultation meeting with our school families and community members. Following this meeting, options will be developed and taken to the Board of Trustees at the June Regular Meeting of the Board.

Families will be made aware of the outcome of the review following the Board meeting with changes to take effect September 2024.
