- Are fun, creative, caring, and energetic.

Responsibilities

- Be a role model through active and inclusive participation in all aspects of the program.
- Support daily programming, such as playing, reading games, supervising children, organizing learning materials, leading activities, and assisting with daily record keeping as needed.
- Take direction from Summer Learning Program teachers.
- Participate in mandatory on-line TLDSB training modules.

- Energetic and positive attitude towards children and learning.
- Demonstrates maturity and professionalism with strong communication skills.
- The Board reserves the right to require a valid Vulnerable Sector Check completed within the past six months for students 18 years or older as a condition of employment.
